MAKE YOUR OWN...

3D DINOSAUR KEYHOLE AND KEY

INSTRUCTIONS

Ignite Imaginations advise that this activity should be carried out under the supervision of an adult.

When cutting, always make sure you ask an adult to help.

For this activity, you'll need: a piece of card (like a cardboard box or cereal box), a piece of paper, a pen, a glue stick, a pair of scissors, some colouring pencils (optional) and some tin foil (optional)

- Take your card and draw a keyhole shape using the template provided, or you can draw your own using a circle and a triangle shape.
- Next, you need to draw the key. You can use the template to draw round or you can draw your own key, using a circle and two rectangles like in the picture.
- Cut out your keyhole. Then, cut out the centre of the keyhole shape to leave a small cardboard border.
- Next, using a piece of paper, draw round the outside of your keyhole shape, as pictured
- Next, cut out your key shape and draw round that shape three more times on your cardboard to make three more keys. Cut out the extra keys. You should have four keys at this point. Now glue them all together.
- Add glue to the outside of the key and keyhole frame and cover it in tin foil so that it looks like they are made of metal.
- On the paper keyhole, draw a picture of your favourite dinosaur in the dinosaur department store. Your dinosaur might be purple, pink or blue. It could be a tall dinosaur, a spiky dinosaur or even an underwater dinosaur.
- Colour in your keyhole drawing and then glue the wrapped cardboard keyhole frame to the front of it.
- Once dry, you could put your keyhole somewhere in your house and peep through to see what your dinosaur is getting up to.



Extra ideas:

Tap the keyhole to awaken your dinosaur.

Let's imagine what it sounds like. It could have a huge roar or a tiny squeak. It might tiptoe through the department store or stomp stomp stomp...

Can you try pretending to be your dinosaur?
