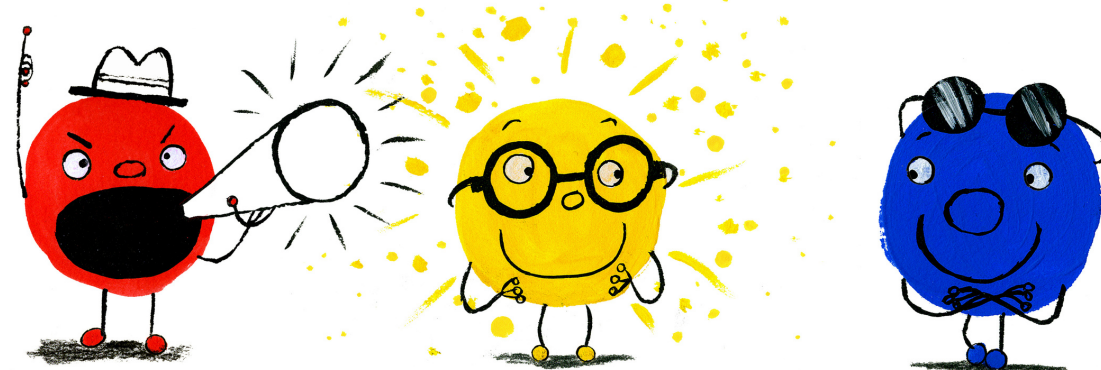

INSTRUCTIONS

Ignite Imaginations advise that this activity should be carried out under the supervision of an adult.
When cutting, always make sure you ask an adult to help.

For this activity, you'll need: Something to draw with (a pen, pencil, crayon or paints)

- 1 Let's create a world for your new bottle-lid characters to explore.
- 2 Look at your city sheet...there aren't many buildings in Mixed city right now. It is time to make the city bigger.
- 3 First, add your home onto the city sheet. Look at what shape your home is...draw the building, does it have a gate or a front door? Add any windows or extra details.
- 4 Now think of other buildings you see in the city. Add some skyscrapers standing tall like big rectangles with lots and lots of windows or perhaps a circus tent or castle.
- 5 In the story there is an ice cream shop and a clothes shop. You can add your favourite shop to the city.
- 6 Where else do you like to go? You could draw a park or a cinema or your own favourite place. Don't forget to add roads and pavements too.
- 7 Using coloured pens or fingerpaints, add new mixed friends for your character to play with. Remember to give your characters arms and legs and any clothes too.
- 8 It's time to move your bottle-lid character into the city to play in. Well Done!
